To put it simply, the new birth is the re-generation of the human spirit to produce a new life in an individual by the working of the Holy Spirit. The new birth also refers to as being 'born again' and it means, to be re-born of God with seed (Christ-The Word) dwelling in man (Jn.3:3, 5; 1 Jn.3:9; 1Pet.1:23). Everyone born naturally inherits the fallen nature of the first Adam that makes us spiritually unclean (Ps.51:5). Therefore, to become spiritually clean as well as a member of the family of God, a new birth becomes necessary.

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

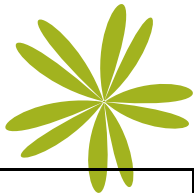
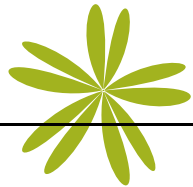
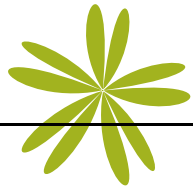
