FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The role of the church in the modern age

Text: Ephesians 3:6-19

A mysterious plan was revealed to Paul in this chapter, which is that Jews and Gentiles share equally in the riches and promises of God. To Paul, his number one mission was to preach about this and the limitless, boundless, endless treasures available to us in Christ (v8-9). When we get to know or receive that revelation, we'll know how amazing Christ is and will place him above all other. God's purpose was to display his wisdom through the church to the world and to principalities and powers (v10).

What do principalities and powers see when they see us?

They see how God has triumphed us over sin and has sent heaven's best to redeem the world's worst. How God has conquered his enemies by love and reclaimed us as a bride for Christ. How God has blessed us with all spiritual blessings. And how God's glory is displayed through the body of Christ, the church of God. He made us co-heirs with Christ and the angels are astonished when they see Satan defeated and Christ enthroned.

We can now come boldly into God's presence to worship and pray together (v11-13). So, to answer the question about the church's role today, it is to understand what Daniel, Esther and Joseph understood long ago. Just as God is using his wisdom to display his glory to principalities and powers, he's using us and his church to do the same here on earth.

How can the church be relevant today?

The sons of Issachar had an understanding of the times (1 Chronicles 12:32). The church must manifest the wisdom of God in the same way and be able to discern the times. We must also reflect the same unity like the sons of Issachar, and be relevant, providing Godly responses and solutions.

The church must be able to answer society's questions. Churches today seem to answer their own questions more often than the ones relevant to the society. We should make ourselves indispensable and operate in excellence, acquire knowledge and skills of the age to manifest the wisdom of God, and educate ourselves beyond theological studies.

We see an example of this in Daniel and his friends (Dan 1:17). Serving under four Babylonian kings, Daniel displayed God's wisdom and answered the questions of his time. For example, a prominent preacher went online to say COVID-19 was caused by 5G. It soon became apparent he didn't know much about the subject. When we don't educate ourselves, we become irrelevant, consigned to the fringes of the society.

Filled with wonder at God's plan, Paul fell to his knees and prayed that God strengthens us because none of these can be achieved without empowerment (v14). We need an understanding of "**the love of Christ which passes knowledge**" and "**be filled with all the fullness of God**". Also, God's spirit is in us and it teaches us about his wisdom (v17-19; John 16:13-15). No challenge can overcome us because Christ overcame (John 16:33).

Bottom line:

We owe ourselves and God the duty to display his wisdom and power to the world around us. Pray that God will give us the grace to identify the challenges we face and how to be relevant to the society, to have an understanding of our roles and display God's power and glory (Rom 8:19; Col 2:2-3).
