FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Living a purposeful life

Text: Ephesians 5:15-20

Last week, we were encouraged to let our thoughts and actions be driven by truth and stop trying to ourselves to justify our actions. We also learnt that the Holy Spirit is the guarantor of our salvation. In our text today, we're asked to live a life that's pleasing to God and not live like fools or be unwise.

We don't need to know when we're going to die to be thoughtful and deliberate in the way we live. One thing we've learnt about the last three and half years of Jesus' life is that he was deliberate and purposeful (John 9:4-5). What are you going to do today and each and every day from now? The lyrics of a children song in the form of a prayer may help.

Day by day dear Lord, of these three things I pray:

To see thee more clearly, love thee more dearly, follow thee more nearly

Day by day

Perhaps these words could offer some pointers to build on for each day and we can meditate further on how we could **see**, **love** or **follow** God more. Another set of guidance suggests the following for each day:

- 1) Do at least one thing you really love to do.
- 2) Do one thing of eternal consequence or value (Eph 2:10).
- 3) Be a blessing to someone e.g. pray for others, fulfill promises or help financially when you can. A phone call may make the difference between life and death for someone.

Also, from today's prayer, the Church of England suggests the following steps:

- 1) Find a place to be still
- 2) Give thanks for the good things of today
- 3) Let go of things bothering you
- 4) Review your day
- 5) Talk with god
- 6) Finish your prayer.

Whatever we choose to do, the important thing is that we're purposeful and consistent in following God. We can speculate from the life of Solomon that the reason his early years were fantastic and he backslid in his later years was because he wasn't as focused on God and things of eternal value towards, distracted by the gods of his 700 wives and 300 concubines (1 Kings 11:3-4).

We can see an example of this consistency in the life of Paul who served God until the end, from his first encounter with Jesus (Acts 22:8-10). His legacy is seen in the churches he started and nurtured all his life. He was purposeful in preaching the gospel to the Gentiles and in the way he lived (2 Tim 4:7-8). We must be just as purposeful.

Bottom line:

Let's live in a way that will glorify God. When we look back, we must be able to give a similar testimony to Paul's (2 Tim 4:7). Let's believe in the infinite power God has deposited in us and not be weary in serving him everyday (Isa 40:31).
