Google Chrome

1. Open the browser and the **Settings** menu (or the **three vertical dots** to the right of the menu bar).
2. Scroll down and click on **Advanced Settings**.
3. Select **Open a specific page or set of pages** under **On Startup**.
4. Select **Set pages** and enter or add <http://rccgbethel.church/>.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox. Press **Alt-T** on the keyboard and select **Options** from the drop-down menu or go to **Tools >> Options** from the main menu.
2. In the **Home** section, select **Homepage and new windows** and **Custom URLs...** from the field's drop down.
3. Enter or paste the URL: <http://rccgbethel.church/> or click **Use Current Page** if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

1. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar.
2. Select **Settings** and select **A Specific Page or Pages** from the **Open Microsoft Edge With** section drop down options.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Activating our divine exemptions

Text: Exodus 9:24-26; 10:22-23; 12:13

There are exemptions in operation all the time, free from liabilities or consequences. For example, a head of state can be exempted from prosecution while in office. As believers, we also have divine exemptions if we claim them. In the above texts, we can see them at work for the children of Israel although they never fully activated those divine exemptions (Ps 49:20).

The following are crucial for claiming those exemptions:

1. An understanding of the scriptures
2. Prayer: Allows us to declare / activate God's words (Isa 42:22; Jer 33:3)
3. Loving God and working in his calling and purpose (Rom 8:28)
4. Operating in the love and spirit of light in Christ Jesus
5. Walking in the spirit (Rev 1:10)
6. Walking in the fear of the Lord (Mal 3:16-17)
7. Being willing and obedient (Isa 1:19)
8. Dwelling in the secret place and proclaiming it (Psa 91:1-2; 16)
9. Consciously / knowingly not accepting any trend that does not comply with the promise of God on your life (Job 22:29)
10. Those in whose lives the glory of God is manifested (Isa 60:1-2)
11. Those who distinctly hear and obey the voice of God (or instructions) to the letter (1 Kings 17:2-16)
12. Believing the report of the Lord (Isa 53:1)

There's nothing we can do that will separate us from the love of God (Rom 8:31-39). But there are certain things we can do that can call in his favour from time to time, including being spared from devastating or evil experience. An important part of this is working in the service of God (Mal 3:17). We can also cite these scriptures as reminders when we pray.

In **Genesis 26**, there was a famine and others were fleeing the land, but God told Isaac not to leave (Gen 26:2-5). Isaac obeyed and contrary to the expected outcomes, he prospered (Gen 26:6; 12-14). Isaac experienced an exception from the devastation that is normal in these circumstances because of God's covenant with his father.

We've also inherited this covenant (Gal 3:14). However, we must learn to accept, believe and decree or declare or proclaim or claim them. We must also yearn to hear distinctly from God. When we do, let's pray for the grace to obey and follow his instructions to the letter so we can operate in those exemptions.

Bottom line:

It is important that we know, understand and believe in the privileges we have in Christ, and learn to declare and activate them in our lives.
