Google Chrome

Mozilla Firefox

- Open Firefox. Press Alt-T on the keyboard and select Options from the drop-down menu or go to Tools >> Options from the main menu.
- In the Home section, select Homepage and new windows and Custom URLs... from the field's drop down.
- Enter or paste the URL: http://rccgbethel.church/ or click Use Current Page if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

It's all in the plan

Text: Matthew 1:18

This was how Jesus, "the lamb who was slaughtered before the world was made", was born. (Rev 13:5-8 NLT). From this verse, it may seem that Mary wasn't given an option. But we know Angel Gabriel already foretold what was going to happen (Lk 1:26-38). It was all part of God's plan, from Adam and Eve's sin in the Garden of Eden to Jesus's crucifixion. God knew man was incapable of meeting his high standards. So, he provided a path of redemption (Rom 5:8).

Some of us are great planners, others wing or take things in stride. God's never caught unawares. He has a plan for everything and has ensured we will have victory in all our trials. Whatever we are going through, we can be reassured that a victorious outcome has been pre-determined for us (1 Cor 10:13). We need not despair when things aren't going well (Psa 37:23-24; 23:1–6).

Some of our plans may not work out the way we imagined or expect them to. However, the end result will always be much better than we can ever think or hope for (Rom 8:28). This is because God is not making it up as he goes along. Every day of our lives is pre-determined and written in his book (Psa 139:16). We are chosen to be overcomers.

Bottom line:

Trust in God's plan for your life. He will yet do what he says he will do (Proverbs 3:5-6).
