Google Chrome

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Teaching moments

Text: Isaiah 30:18-21

In our study through Isaiah, we've explored and learnt a lot from Chapter 30. One of these is that Jesus is a pathfinder ((Isa 30:20-21), but that doesn't really capture the essence of Jesus's ability to guide us. This is because Jesus can make a way where there's none. He parted the Red Sea when it was necessary, providing water in the desert and so on. He becomes the way (Jn 14:6).

Reading several Scripture translations may lead to greater understanding of what God is telling us. For example, the word translated into the singular word, "*teacher*" in New Living and Amplified translations was plural "*teachers*" in King James Version. The word can mean to throw / cast, shoot, point / show, direct / teach / instruct, or to throw water or rain, guiding its trajectory (Prov 21:1).

Our lives are often shaped by teaching moments or turning points, when we're guided by the right person in a way that changes the course of our lives (Acts 8:4-8; 36-40). In contrast, some can guide us to follow the wrong way. May we never hear the wrong voice at those moments in Jesus name.

At certain moments in our lives, we may need someone to build our confidence, speak words that will unlock difficult problems or present an issue in a new perspective for us. On reflection, many of us may recognise those moments in our lives. The truth is the end does not justify the means in Christianity (Rom 8:14).

Bottom line:

Pray today that God will send you the right person to guide you aright always at those teaching moments in Jesus name.
