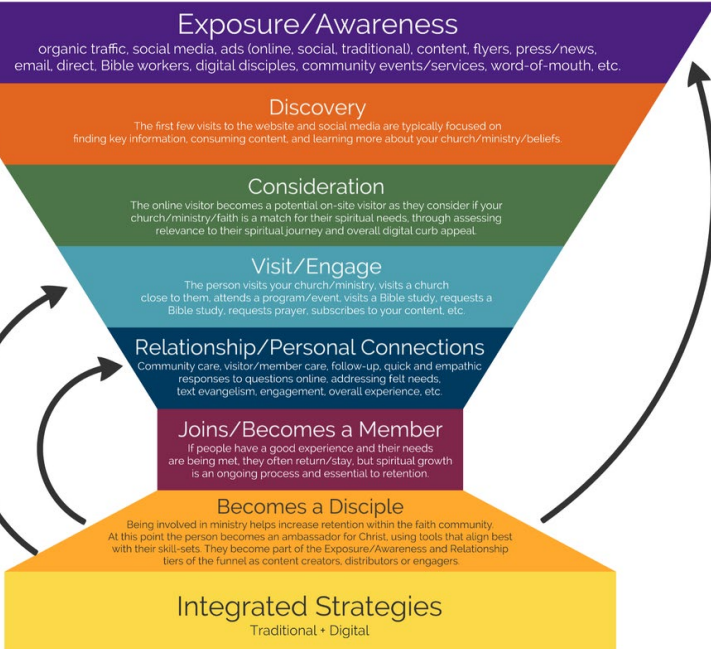

The modern seeker's journey



Exposure/Awareness

organic traffic, social media, ads (online, social, traditional), content, flyers, press/news, email, direct, Bible workers, digital disciples, community events/services, word-of-mouth, etc.

Discovery

The first few visits to the website and social media are typically focused on finding key information, consuming content, and learning more about your church/ministry/beliefs.

Consideration

The online visitor becomes a potential on-site visitor as they consider if your church/ministry/faith is a match for their spiritual needs, through assessing relevance to their spiritual journey and overall digital curb appeal.

Visit/Engage

The person visits your church/ministry, visits a church close to them, attends a program/event, visits a Bible study, requests a Bible study, requests prayer, subscribes to your content, etc.

Relationship/Personal Connections

Community care, visitor/member care, follow-up, quick and empathic responses to questions online, addressing felt needs, text evangelism, engagement, overall experience, etc.

Joins/Becomes a Member

If people have a good experience and their needs are being met, they often return/stay, but spiritual growth is an ongoing process and essential to retention.

Becomes a Disciple

Being involved in ministry helps increase retention within the faith community. At this point the person becomes an ambassador for Christ, using tools that align best with their skill-sets. They become part of the Exposure/Awareness and Relationship tiers of the funnel as content creators, distributors or engagers.

So, why don't you set our homepage as one of your **startup page(s)** in your browser now? The following instructions for most of the common browsers may help.

Google Chrome

1. Open the browser and the **Settings** menu (or the **three vertical dots** to the right of the menu bar).
2. Scroll down and click on **Advanced Settings**.
3. Select **Open a specific page or set of pages** under **On Startup**.
4. Select **Set pages** and enter or add <http://rccgbethel.church/>.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox. Press **Alt-T** on the keyboard and select **Options** from the drop-down menu or go to **Tools >> Options** from the main menu.
2. In the **Home** section, select **Homepage and new windows** and **Custom URLs...** from the field's drop down.
3. Enter or paste the URL: <http://rccgbethel.church/> or click **Use Current Page** if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

1. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar.
2. Select **Settings** and select **A Specific Page or Pages** from the **Open Microsoft Edge With** section drop down options.
3. Enter <http://rccgbethel.church/>. (Click the Plus sign to add more pages if required).
4. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar again to close **Settings** menu.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Effective modern day evangelism

Text: Luke 10:1-10; Jonah 3:4; Mark 16:15-20

This is about focusing on authentic relationships and lifestyle role modelling as opposed to confrontational, traditional one-size-fits-all methods. The world is changing from the days of market square proclamations. For example, WhatsApp status / social media can be used to broadcast inspiring messages to family members, close friends or those looking for similar posts.

However, while the Internet may seem a no-brainer as a medium, there are drawbacks. How do we reach those that do not fall in our immediate / known circles? How do we overcome short attention spans or influence algorithm-driven messages? Although, we may not be able to control all the parameters, we all have personal testimonies to share (Acts 22:6-21).

God is the only one who can save (Psa 49:7-8; Jn 15:16), but we're commanded to pass on the good news of the gospel (Matt 28:18-20). After all, how shall people hear unless they're informed (Rom 10:14). We may be able to find guidelines on how to live to Jesus at work or in other public spaces. Other means include wearing clothing / accessories that proclaims our faith.

Prayers are also key because they go places we're unable to. However, we're enjoined to obey the laws of the land, avoid infringing on rights and be sensitive to others perspectives. Attempting to force the Gospel message on others or being confrontational is likely to invoke rancor and may be counter-productive.

We learn from Jesus who instructed his disciples to abandon cities where they're rejected (Lk 10:10-12). Social media and AI provide extensive opportunities. We can employ skills and capabilities already at our grasp, such as writing, singing, comedy acts, artistic compilations or other interests, to enhance or facilitate effective engagement with more people.

Training on more advanced skills are also available / easily accessible. These are transferrable skills into other spheres of life. When we create platforms that promote the Gospel and engage with others about our faith, we become active contributors rather than passive consumers, as we overcome challenges / reluctance (Hab 3:19).

Bottom line:

The Internet can be a treasure trove for varying interests, including pornography, connections with new people and so on. They're pushed / marketed to us whether we like it or not, and often, we're just passive consumers. We can be active ambassadors of Christ in these digital spheres with our insights, leading many to Christ.
