Google Chrome

1. Open the browser and the **Settings** menu (or the **three vertical dots** to the right of the menu bar).
2. Scroll down and click on **Advanced Settings**.
3. Select **Open a specific page or set of pages** under **On Startup**.
4. Select **Set pages** and enter or add <http://rccgbethel.church/>.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox. Press **Alt-T** on the keyboard and select **Options** from the drop-down menu or go to **Tools >> Options** from the main menu.
2. In the **Home** section, select **Homepage and new windows** and **Custom URLs...** from the field's drop down.
3. Enter or paste the URL: <http://rccgbethel.church/> or click **Use Current Page** if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

1. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar.
2. Select **Settings** and select **A Specific Page or Pages** from the **Open Microsoft Edge With** section drop down options.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The God kind of faith: Mechanics of faith

Text: Mark 11:12-14; 20-22

For faith to produce an outcome, but it requires a relationship with God unencumbered by past experiences. It requires a childlike faith like the one that made young Samuel follow Eli's instructions without question (1 Sam 3:5-10). It is worry-free and trusting, daring, fearless and tender-hearted (Matt 18:1-3; Mk 11:22 TPT).

We're called to live by faith (Rom 1:17; Gal 3:1; Heb 10:38). Then we can live a beautiful life because believing is seeing (Heb 11:1). If we're not, we're working by sight. The God kind of faith believes in the heart and speaks with the mouth (Rom 10:9-10). To operate in the God kind of faith, we need to know the following:

- 1) We already have the God kind of faith** (Heb 11:6; 10:38; Rom 1:17; 10:10; Gal 3:2; 5; Acts 2:37-41; 4:4; 10:44-48; 14:8-10). A measure imparted at the new birth (Rom 12:3).
- 2) We can grow in our faith** (2 Thes 1:3). Faith comes by hearing and by the word of God (Rom 10:17). Just like our muscles begin to degenerate without exercise, we can see our faith in action when exercised daily. God already provided (Matt 6:33; Eph 1:3; Psa 23).
- 3) The God kind of faith's not presumption or foolishness.** It is of the heart. The devil quoted the word of God each time he tempted Jesus (Matt 4:5-7). Jesus resisted because it was foolishness. He already knew he was the son of God. Likewise, we're already healed (1 Pet 2:24; Isa 53:4-5; cf Matt 8:17; Rev 12:11). When we concentrate on physical ailments / circumstances, we're working by sight. By faith, we take what belongs to us, and now (Heb 11:1). It isn't hope. Believe the moment you pray (Mk 11:24; Jn 11:41-43; Isa 55:11).
- 4) Faith works by love** (Gal 5:6). This is most crucial. Faith will not work out of love. That's the agape kind which is unconditional love of God. A love that is enduring, patience, forgives, not envious or boastful, doesn't insist on its own right or think evil of anyone (1 Cor 13:1-7 AMPC). When you fight for yourself, God steps aside (Ex 14:14; Lk 23:34).
- 5) Faith works by complete obedience** (Heb 11:8). God's already spoken to us by his word and will speak in our heart through his Holy Spirit. We must obey (2 Kings 5:9-13).
- 6) Faith works by righteousness consciousness** (Rom 3:21-26; 5:17; 2 Cor 5:21; 17). Righteousness was imputed to us at new birth. We're never going to be more righteous than we are right now. We're either righteous or not.
- 7) Faith must be released with our mouth** (Mk 11:23). Christians often believe, but fail to confess. We must release our faith and confess it with our mouth (Phil 4:13; 3 Cor 9:8; Heb 4:14; 2 Cor 4:13; 1 Tim 6:12).

Hope waits. Faith receives. The confession of our faith will create the reality of what we see in our lives. What has God said about you? God said he will never leave us and we can boldly say he's our helper (Heb 13:5-6). He said we're his righteousness. We're already healed. We're prosperous and blessed (Eph 1:3). Don't say anything contrary to God (1 Jn 5:4).

Bottom line:

When the devil holds you in the arena of reasoning, he's won. We are a new creation (2 Cor 5:17) and we're righteous. Old things have become new. Let's live by faith.
