Google Chrome

1. Open the browser and the **Settings** menu (or the **three vertical dots** to the right of the menu bar).
2. Scroll down and click on **Advanced Settings**.
3. Select **Open a specific page or set of pages** under **On Startup**.
4. Select **Set pages** and enter or add <http://rccgbethel.church/>.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox. Press **Alt-T** on the keyboard and select **Options** from the drop-down menu or go to **Tools >> Options** from the main menu.
2. In the **Home** section, select **Homepage and new windows** and **Custom URLs...** from the field's drop down.
3. Enter or paste the URL: <http://rccgbethel.church/> or click **Use Current Page** if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

1. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar.
2. Select **Settings** and select **A Specific Page or Pages** from the **Open Microsoft Edge With** section drop down options.
3. Enter <http://rccgbethel.church/>. (Click the Plus sign to add more pages if required).
4. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar again to close **Settings** menu.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Arise and build

Text: Isaiah 60:1

This is a call to restoration, responsibility and kingdom advancement. It is a call to ownership, to action and to legacy. Age is not a barrier and there's no limit to what God can do with a man. It is to accept a burden (Neh 2:17-18). What is the burden God has given you? We're called to shine God's glory wherever he's placed us (Matt 5:14). Not to blend in.

We're called to respond to divine stirring, to receive a launchpad onto the next level. Stop blaming and start owning, because we're called to occupy until Jesus returns (Lk 19:13). People refuse to arise because of they're full of excuses. They're also afraid of opposition. Some may be too comfortable with their positions (Rom 8:37). Others are weary or they procrastinate. Some doubt.

Take that step (Isa 43:18-19). No more excuses (Jn 5:7). Be a man or woman of faith (Gen 12:1; Phil 4:13) because with God, nothing's impossible (Lk 1:37). To win souls, pray, start a business or a new career, start now. Don't allow doubt (Jn 2:5).

We're called to build and do something for God (Hag 1:8; Matt 28:19). God placed us where we are for a purpose, to influence, impact and preach the Gospel. We're called to build and make time for our families (Psa 127:1-2). To build our church (Matt 16:18). Church is a community and not a building. We're also called to build mountains of culture / new innovations for Christ.

Bottom line:

Forget the former things. Take the first step in faith. Arise and build.
