Google Chrome

1. Open the browser and the **Settings** menu (or the **three vertical dots** to the right of the menu bar).
2. Scroll down and click on **Advanced Settings**.
3. Select **Open a specific page or set of pages** under **On Startup**.
4. Select **Set pages** and enter or add <http://rccgbethel.church/>.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox. Press **Alt-T** on the keyboard and select **Options** from the drop-down menu or go to **Tools >> Options** from the main menu.
2. In the **Home** section, select **Homepage and new windows** and **Custom URLs...** from the field's drop down.
3. Enter or paste the URL: <http://rccgbethel.church/> or click **Use Current Page** if you are already on our website.

Microsoft Edge

1. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar.
2. Select **Settings** and select **A Specific Page or Pages** from the **Open Microsoft Edge With** section drop down options.
3. Enter <http://rccgbethel.church/>. (Click the Plus sign to add more pages if required).
4. Click the **three horizontal dots** to the right of the top menu bar again to close **Settings** menu.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Arise to build and to plant

Text: Jeremiah 1:1-14

The church's theme for this year is to build or rebuild (Neh 2:17) and today's text is an example of where, how and exactly what to build (Jer 1:10). Like Nehemiah and Jeremiah, we also have to answer the universal call to build or restore. It requires actionable plans including surveys, assessments, connections etc. The need for building or rebuilding is continuous and important (Lk 18:8).

Builders must be visionary (Hos 4:6; Hab 2:3) and carry out constant assessments (Heb 4:16). They and must build according to pattern (Ex 25:9). But first, they must build ourselves (Jud 20-21). Also, we build our children. Children should not only be brought to church, but to Christ (Prov 22:6; Matt 7:17-20) and we can build wherever we are in the world (Matt 28:19-20; Psa 122:6; Acts 1:8).

Building according to God's pattern means aligning our plans with divine patterns and not according to human tendencies, obeying the leading of the Holy Spirit even if it seems illogical at first. It involves intentional / deliberate planning and radical obedience. God requires those who are sold out (Phil 1:21). Christians can build for God in every sphere of life, in local kingship or politics. Connect with disciples / destiny helpers, relevant authorities and like-minded people (Neh 2:4).

Build disciples that will also disciple others (Matt 28:19) and at the correct timing. Nehemiah and Esther chose the right times. Be discerning for detractors and be prepared to keep them from disrupting the plan (Neh 4:1-3; Lk 22:36). Be available and partner with God. He will give you success in all areas. May God give you a new song as you build in Jesus name (Neh. 2:20 Psa 126:5-6).

Bottom line:

We have a mandate to reconcile people to their creator (2 Cor 5:18). Pray that God will build / rebuild through you and give you the grace to build according to his pattern.
